New Updated Revision for the Stratagy IVP8

Toshiba is pleased to announce the immediate availability of an updated model of the Stratagy IVP8. This second revision of our most popular voice mail system has an enhanced hardware design that includes more voice storage and a faster internal modem to make remote maintenance easier and more efficient.

Storage Increase

The Stratagy IVP8 Rev.2 board is factory equipped with 256 megabytes of Compact Flash storage. This equates to up to 15 hours of storage right out of the box! That's an 11 hour improvement from the previous version! Actual message storage is dependent on the quantity and length of system and personal greetings as well as recorded user names.

Faster Internal Modem

Stratagy IVP8 Rev.2 has an internal modem with a transmission speed of up to 14,400 baud. This is a tremendous improvement from the previous Stratagy IVP8's 2400 baud modem! Faster modem speeds enable dealer technicians or System Administrators to call into the system remotely and perform maintenance and administration tasks more quickly and efficiently.

Stratagy Admin Software

Administration of Stratagy IVP8 Rev.2 requires the use of XADM 4.0 Administration Software. This is the same Stratagy Admin software that is required for the administration of the GVMU integrated voice mail system for the new Strata CTX28.

Important! *Earlier versions of Stratagy Admin software are not compatible with the Stratagy IVP8 Rev.2. Conversely, XADM 4.0 is not compatible with Stratagy IVP8 Rev.1 systems. Only use XADM 4.0 Administration software with the new Stratagy IVP8 Rev.2 board or GVMU voice mail systems.*

Pricing

This is where it gets good! The new Stratagy IVP8 Rev.2, with its enhanced design, additional storage and faster internal modem sells for the same price as the old Stratagy IVP8. That's right, increased value but NOT with an increased price!

Port Upgrades

The Stratagy IVP8 Rev.2 board can be upgraded using the same process as the previous IVP8 system. The only difference is that new part numbers are required. They are:

2 to 4 port upgrade – SG-IVP8-R2-2UP4

4 to 6 port upgrade – SG-IVP8-R2-4UP6

6 to 8 port upgrade – SG-IVP8-R2-6UP8

Once an upgrade is ordered, retrieve the Stratagy DK/Flash/IVP8 Request form from FYI. Fill in the pertinent information and fax it to the appropriate number. Technical Support can then call into the system and perform the upgrade.

Storage Upgrade Option

A storage upgrade option is also available with the Stratagy IVP8 Rev.2 board. This option is for a 512 megabyte Compact Flash card that is factory installed with the ROM DOS operating system. This upgrade should bring the over all storage to just over 30 hours. This option is only available for Stratagy IVP8 Rev.2 and can be ordered using part number SG-IVP8-R2-512M. This is the only Compact Flash upgrade supported by Toshiba for the Stratagy IVP8 Rev.2.

Documentation

An Installation Guide, providing instructions for installing and powering up the system for the first time is included with each Stratagy IVP8 Rev. 2 board that is shipped. A copy of this Installation Guide is also posted on Internet FYI.

The Stratagy IVP8 Rev.2 board can be ordered using the following part numbers:

2 ports – SG-IVP8-R2-2

4 ports – SG-IVP8-R2-4

6 ports – SG-IVP8-R2-6

8 ports – SG-IVP8-R2-8
